DID YOU KNOW?

All customers renting a travel trailer are required to watch a safety video prior to checking out equipment. For boats, the Texas Parks and Wildlife training is required. Some restrictions may apply. Proof of vehicle insurance required for all towable rental equipment.

RESERVATION FEE

Full rental fee is due at time of reservation.

RENTAL NOTES

All items must be picked up by 3 p.m. Allow one hour for check-out/check-in of items. It is the customer's responsibility to load and unload all rental equipment.

CANCELLATIONS

There will be a \$10 administrative fee for cancellations. Cancellation must be made seven business days prior to checkout. Rain checks will be given for cancellations made within seven days of pickup.

DAMAGED & CLEANING FEES

All equipment returned dirty and/or wet will be assessed a cleaning fee of up to \$100. Missing or damaged parts will be assessed full replacement cost. Damage to equipment will be assessed actual repair cost.

TOWABLE

Proof of Insurance is required for rental of any towables equipment and a Class "3" receiver bar.

SUPPLIES FOR MACHINES

Required additional supplies for rental equipment such as propane, ice, syrup, popcorn, etc. are the responsibility of the customer.

Annual Permits and Family Passes are available for the archery range, gun range or a combination for both ranges. The permits and passes are valid for one calendar year from date of purchase.

ARCHERY RANGE

The archery range includes a covered shooting line with six (6) targets spaced at ten (10) yard intervals. All types of bows are permitted including crossbows. DoD ID cardholders may sponsor two guests who do not have a DoD ID card to the range.

RANGE RULES:

- All individuals must check in at the ORC, a 100% ID check.
- Broadheads are prohibited on the range.
- Be aware of wildlife.
- Be cautious of other shooters.

ARCHERY BOW RENTALS: Cost: \$20 per bow

Recurve bows are available for rent at the archery range. With a draw weight of twenty (20) pounds, they are easy to use for most age groups. Basic safety instructions are provided upon rental.

3D ARCHERY SHOOT

The 3D Archery Shoot takes place on the first Saturday and Sunday of the month from January to September. The event features thirty (30) life-like 3D animal targets, including alligators, bear, deer, zombies, and more. Targets are positioned at unknown distances ranging from five (5) to fifty-five (55) yards. Both compound and traditional (longbow, recurves) are permitted. Crossbows are not allowed.

GUN RANGE (SPORTSMAN’S RANGE)

The gun range is scheduled to be opened on Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., weather and unit training permitting. Last call to the range is at 2 p.m. DoD ID cardholders may sponsor two non-DoD ID cardholders to the range. Age restriction of ten (10) years of age. Maximum Caliber allowed is 7.62, 30.06, and .308. Super magnums like a 300 Win Mag are prohibited on the range.

To ensure the safety of all shooters, it is required to adhere to the following gun range rules. Failure to comply with these rules or endangering other shooters will result in the immediate expulsion from the range. By signing the Waiver of Liability, you acknowledge and accept these rules as your only warning.

CONCEALED/OPEN CARRY IS NOT AUTHORIZED ON BASE AND ON THE FIRING LINE.

Range Status:

Cold Status: During cold status, all firing ceases to allow shooters to change targets. Handling firearms is strictly prohibited during this period, including packing up to leave.

Hot Status: During the hot status, shooters are permitted to handle and shoot firearms.

GENERAL RULES

- Follow all instructions given by the Range Safety Officer (RSO).
- Concealed/Open carry is strictly prohibited on base and on the firing line (HOLSTERS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON YOUR PERSON.)
- ALL firearms must be transported in a case. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Shooter(s) is/are responsible for picking up their brass from the firing line and grass areas.
- Shooters are responsible for setting up and returning their target stands. The maximum distance allowed is 100 yards.
- Only one (1) target stand is allowed per table.
- Keep all firearms pointed down range.
- Rapid fire is not permitted. (This includes Bump-Stocks)
- All weapons are to be cased and uncased on the firing line.
- A round count of each caliber fired must be provided to the RSO before leaving the range.
- Limit three (3) firearms per table at a time per person.
- No Automatics/Full Auto (This includes Three (3) round burst guns)

COLD STATUS RULES

- Follow all instructions given by the RSO.
- All firearms must be cleared, bolts/slides/breaches locked/opened.
- Touching of weapons during a cold status is prohibited. This includes any empty or broken-down guns, as well as sight adjustments.
- Shooter(s) may set up equipment such as spotting scopes and targets.
- Shooter(s) may load magazines with ammunition away from the firing line.
- Shooters must stay behind the yellow line unless placing targets or picking up brass from all areas, to include the grass and all around the shooter.

HOT STATUS RULES

- Follow all instructions given by the RSO.
- Ear and eye protection must be always worn.
- Do not cross the black line/tables.
- Do not draw from the hip.
- Non-shooters must remain off the firing line unless spotting for a shooter.
- All firearms being shot must remain on the table and on the firing line.
- Shooter(s) may only handle weapons during this time.
- Rapid fire is not permitted. (This includes Bump-Stocks)
