## SPONSORSHIP

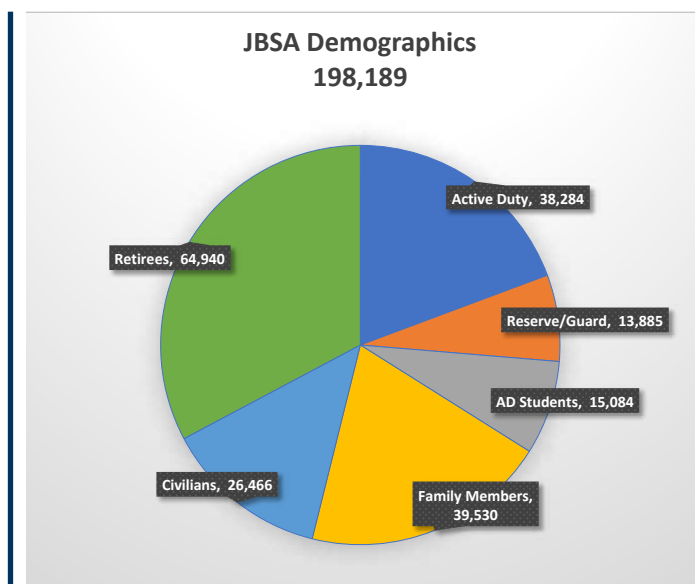
### WHY?

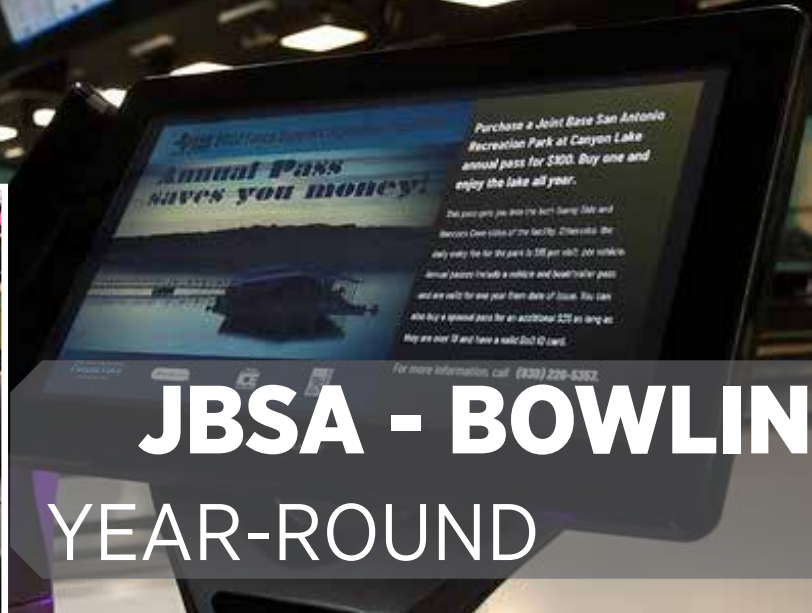

In addition, they host several UFC Fight Nights that each get over 350 attendees.

Arnold Hall Community Center on JBSA-Lackland is honored to host several events that serve an engaged and diverse audience, with over 400 attendees encompassing active-duty military, esteemed veterans, dedicated DoD civilians, and their supportive families. They proudly host more than 12 spectacular events each year, ranging from themed bingo nights, karaoke contests, and trivia nights to innovative cooking and baking contests. Additionally, they also host legacy events including the much-anticipated Doggy Easter Hunt, Second Chance Prom, Halloween Boo Bash, Giant Holiday Card Contest, and Family Talent Show.

Joint Base San Antonio (JBSA) is home to the largest Fitness and Sports Program in the Air Force. The team of 120 Fitness professionals serve 2.7 million customers annually across 11 fitness centers, two aquatics centers and 10 outdoor sports facilities. They host various sporting events to include Armed Forces Tournament, Air Force Sports Trial Camps, Wounded Warrior Games, Defender Cup Varsity Soccer Tournament, National Military Basketball Tournament and Texas State Varsity Softball Tournament. They also offer monthly Bench Press Contests, Tire Flip Contests, 5K Run/Walks, Deadlift Contests, Rower Challenges, Three-Point Basketball Shootouts, Circuit Challenges, Push-Up/Sit-Ups Contests and more to encourage JBSA team members to challenge themselves both mentally and physically to improve their fitness levels.
